Motion for Stay/ Extension

Dear Ms. Kitchings:

By joint motion on August 25, 2023, the parties to the above referenced appeal requested a stay of the deadlines in this appeal while the resolution of the matter is pending approval with the circuit/ probate court. On August 28, 2023, the Court granted that motion. The Court's order granting that motion required we notify the court within 30 days if additional time was needed. We provided notice to the court on September 26, 2023, that this matter was still pending resolution. On October 2, 2023, the Court forwarded a letter to the parties to this appeal granting an additional 30 day stay and requesting another update on the status of the approval in 30 days. On November 1, 2023, the parties provided a status update to the Court, and on November 6, 2023, the Court granted a continued stay and requested an update in 30 days.
