Dear Ms. Kitchings:

I am in receipt of the Court's letter of December 1, 2023 regarding Appellant-Respondent Fast Formliners Company's ("Fast Formliners") Amended Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal, a copy of which is attached. This document was filed on November 28, 2023, simultaneously with Fast Formliners' Reply Brief (also attached). It was intended to supplement Fast Formliners' Designation of Matter filed on September 5, 2023. I suspect including the word "Amended" in the title gave the mistaken impression that the document functioned as more than the supplementation of the September 5, 2023 Designation that is often done upon filing reply briefs.

My paralegal spoke with the case manager, Khee'Asia Evans-Pryor, who recommended that we write this letter requesting clarification.

While Fast Formliners would be glad to file a motion to amend if the Court deems it necessary, I would request confirmation from the Court as to whether this letter's explanation of Fast Formliners' obviates the need for a motion to amend or if correcting the Amended Designation would be more suitable or convenient for the Court.


