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## ORDER

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This appeal arises out of an order denying the appellant's motion to proceed in forma pauperis by the circuit court. Despite numerous attempts to cure the deficiencies in his proof of service for the notice of appeal, the appellant has failed to provide proof of timely service of the notice of appeal upon the named respondents to the appeal. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed. *See Elam v. S.C. Dep't of Transp.*, 361 S.C. 9, 14-15, 602 S.E.2d 772, 775 (2004) (holding the requirement of timely service of the notice of appeal is jurisdictional and the appellate court lacks jurisdiction to extend or ignore the deadline); Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR (requiring a notice of appeal be served on all respondents within 30 days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order on appeal). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
