It appears that Defendant, is in default on the Complaint filed by Plaintiff as evidenced by the Affidavit of Default on file by counsel for the Plaintiff.

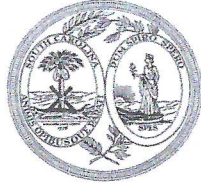
