MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR APPELLANT’S INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, Appellant MECO, Inc. of Augusta (“MECO”) moves for an extension of time in which to serve and file Appellant’s Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.
