**Reply to Return**

I, Tammy Brinson PR Executor of Estate James F Murrell, of Moncks Corner, in Berkeley County, South Carolina, MAKE OATH AND SAY THAT:

1. The appellants were ordered to pay the Bond to Stay on Appeal on the 3rd day of each month beginning August 3, 2023. The appellants have not made any payments for August, September, October, November nor December of 2023. No payment was mailed by the Appellant, no payment was received by the Respondent. The fact that the Appellant shows she wrote checks that were never mailed, never received and never negotiated by her bank should not count as payments made. There is no proof of delivery, nor is there proof the Appellant, Melissa Freeman, ever made a payment of any kind because she did not. The images provided by Melissa Freeman, Wesley Carpenter and/or Joe Martin are fake checks intended to deceive the Appellate Court into allowing the Appellants more time to live for free.
2. The Appellants are also making false police reports in regards to the rented premises being burglarized and attempted arson. A copy of the police report showing Berkeley County Sheriff's Office closed the investigation due to lack of evidence as there is no evidence. The Respondent was at work that day. Surveillance cameras have now been installed to

show the rental premises and who enters it since Melissa Freeman and Wesley Carpenter regularly call the police to report imaginary crime scenes to extend their free stay of 132 Murrell's Inlet Lane. Ms. Freeman has also expressed that she is planning to sue my deceased father's estate and myself for imaginary punitive damages. I would like to finally grieve the loss of my father without threat of tenants who refuse to vacate my family home, in peace, without the worry of the Appellants filing false police reports to try and have me falsely imprisoned.

- 3. The final fact to please consider is that the original landlord is deceased as of April 5, 2023. The lease is expired and the Tenants listed as Appellants in this case have not and refuse to pay rent since March of 2023 which makes nine months since they paid rent or the Bond to Stay payments.

On 11/22/2023 Deputies responded to 132 Murrells Inlet Lane, Moncks Corner, SC in Berkeley County in reference to a Burglary. On arrival I spoke to the victim Melisa Ann Freeman who stated that around 1600 to 1700 hours on this date she came home to find her front door open. Once she entered her residence, she noticed the home had been rummaged through. Freeman said that along with a lamp being knocked over and coffee table turned over. The drawers in the bedroom were pulled out and contents strewn on the floor. Everything on bathroom counter was pushed into the sink. The bathroom mirror had "CRACKHEAD" written in red marker. The hallway wall had a hole punched or kicked into it along with "CRACKHEAD" again written in red ink. Deputies could not see any forced entry at the doors or windows. Freeman also stated that the landlord, Tammy Brinson and herself have had issues in the past. Freeman states she has texts and phone calls from Brinson threatening



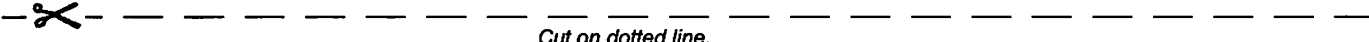
