

ORDER

Appellant filed a motion to expedite on November 20, 2023. Because Appellant failed to provide the filing fee, this court sent a deficiency letter to Appellant on November 21, 2023. The deficiency was cured the same day. Thereafter, Respondent contacted this court inquiring about a due date for a response to the motion. Although the time had passed for filing a response, this court allowed Respondent ten days from December 12, 2023, to file a return. Respondent filed her return on December 19, 2023. Appellant filed a reply, asking this court to strike the return as untimely. In light of this court allowing Respondent additional time to file the return, we deny Appellant's request to strike the return.

After careful consideration of Appellant's motion to expedite, Respondent's return, and Appellant's reply, we deny the motion to expedite.
