Dear Ms. Kitchings:

As you recall, on December 21, 2023, I filed an *Ex Parte Emergency Petition for Writ of Supersedeas* to prevent Mr. Turner's property from being sold on January 2, 2023. Thereafter, you issued a letter to opposing counsel to file a return not later than December 29, 2023.

I am writing to request that you present the Petition to a single judge today because waiting for a return to be filed on December 29, 2023, could cause the property to be sold without having the Writ decided. For example, if the Respondent files the Return after the Court closes on the 29<sup>th</sup>, this will mean that the Court would not consider the Writ until January 2, 2023, the day of the sale. The 30<sup>th</sup> is a weekend, the 31<sup>st</sup> is a weekend, and the 1<sup>st</sup> of January is a holiday, of course. To that end, I request that the Court decide the Writ, *ex parte*, if necessary, pending the receipt of the return—like it did for the first Writ of Supersedeas.
