ORDER

Appellant has filed a motion to relieve Caroline Witz as counsel. After careful consideration, we grant the motion to relieve Attorney Witz. Further, we hold this appeal in abeyance for thirty days from the date of this order to allow Appellant an opportunity to retain new counsel. If we do not receive a notice of appearance from new counsel at the conclusion of the abeyance period, we will presume Appellant will proceed pro se. Although we hold the timelines for perfecting the appeal in abeyance for thirty days, this does not relieve Appellant of her obligation to file an undertaking in compliance with the statute as required by this court's order of December 20, 2023. Failure to file the undertaking will result in denial of the motion for stay.
