Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellants Brock Owen McGrew and Anastasia McGrew, through their undersigned counsel, respectfully request a thirty (30) day extension of time to file Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.
