## ORDER

---

Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied. *See Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 535, 471 S.E.2d 134, 134-35 (1995) ("In the absence of a statutory provision allowing the general waiver of filing fees, we conclude motions to proceed in forma pauperis may only be granted where specifically authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions.").

Appellant's motion to compel is denied. There is no right to discovery on appeal. Only matters designated for inclusion in the record on appeal—in the parties' designations of matter—and presented to the court below shall be included in the record on appeal. *See* Rule 210, SCACR ("The Record on Appeal shall include all matter designated to be included by any party under Rule 209 and shall comply with the requirements of Rule 267. The Record shall not, however, include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").

Finally, Appellant's motion to "dismiss" the order on appeal is denied. To the extent it is Appellant's intent to file a Rule 60(b), SCRCF, motion for a new trial with the circuit court, Appellant must first seek leave to do so with this court.
