number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Terrio J. Thomas with the Court of Appeals on December 4, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for Rehearing in the case of The State v. Levy Larkin Brown with the Court of Appeals on November 22, 2023

5. On January 2, 2024, opposing counsel, the Attorney General's Office, graciously consented to this extension request by way of general consent granted in writing, by Deputy Attorney General Donald J. Zelenka for all Appellate Defense extensions through January 31, 2024.
