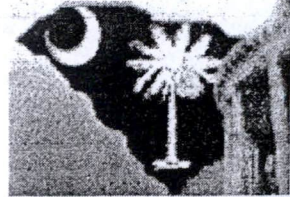

NARRATIVE

Burglary 1st at 7502 Hunt Club RD 2D Victim- Charles Nottingham Suspect- Terrance Gilbert Adams

At About 1200 hours I received a phone call from Jill the apartment manager from 7502 Hunt Club Rd. She said the UPS man was delivering a package and found an apartment possibly broken into. I told her I was enroute to her. I then called dispatch to have a marked unit enroute as well. Several minutes later dispatch advised me the suspect may still be on scene after receiving another call in reference to this incident. When I arrived Jill was standing in front with the maintenance man. The maintenance man said he and the UPS man saw the suspect talking on the phone at the Foodfare. I notified dispatch and asked the maintenance man to accompany me to ID the suspect. When we pulled in to the gas station the maintenance man stated the suspect was on the phone in front of the store. A blue bag and a red and white bag were beside him. I gave out his description on the radio and walked to him. I asked him what he was doing and he handed me a letter he was reading. I asked him for ID and he refused saying I had no right. I asked him to stand up and he refused. I grabbed his wrist and commanded him to stand up as Deputy Soto arrived on scene. He reached toward his pocket and I could see his pocket bulging with an unknown item. I stated to Soto the suspect was reaching for something in his pocket. We tried to handcuff the suspect as we placed him on the wall. The suspect actively fought reaching for his pockets and refusing to obey officers as he pushed off swinging his arms. Assistance arrived and he was handcuffed. During the struggle the suspect received bruises to his face area. EMS responded and transported him to the RMH where he was treated and released. Both bags and the suspect's pockets were full of stolen items from six burglaries from the apartment complex. Three victims arrived on scene and identified their property (Nottingham, Cofield and Drayton). I brought the suspect to RCSD and placed him in the holding cell. While inside he vandalized a partition removing two 2 inch screws. He asked investigators if he could be unhandcuffed to use the bathroom. Inv Coxwell observed the suspect clinching his fist. At that time investigators removed the two screws from the suspects hands. A diamond wedding band was removed from the suspect's hand as well. The suspect stated it was his but it was described by a victim as coming from their burglarized home ( Nottingham). The suspect was transported to AGDC. The investigation continues. Video of the incident at 7500 Hunt Club Rd was taken in to evidence. The video shows the suspect walking to the Foodfare with the two bags over his shoulder and using the phone.
