COMES NOW Appellant, Hallmark Longterm Care, LLC d/b/a Hallmark Healthcare Center, by and through its undersigned counsel, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, and moves for an extension of fifteen (15) days' additional time to file/serve a petition for rehearing of this matter, which the Court decided via opinion filed December 13, 2023. *See Walker v. Hallmark Longterm Care, LLC*, Unpublished Op. No. 2023-UP-400.

Presently, by order of this Court filed December 29, 2023, the deadline to petition for rehearing is January 12, 2024. Because of work-related and other time commitments, the undersigned counsel for Appellant requests the Court's allowance of fifteen (15) days' additional time to petition for rehearing. Respectfully, the undersigned submits there is good cause for the Court to grant the relief requested herein, as it is, under the circumstances, a reasonable dispensation, timely sought, consistent with the interests of justice, posing no threat of undue prejudice to any other party.
