## ORDER

Respondent filed a motion to "disallow Appellant's brief and extend Respondent's time to answer." Respondent noted that Appellant's initial brief references discovery depositions that were not admitted below. Respondent explains, "Presumably, [Appellant] relied on the discovery depositions because the trial transcript has never been provided to either party." Appellant filed a return providing that both parties ordered the transcript, and Appellant's counsel was recently contacted by the court reporter, who advised counsel that the transcript will be provided to the parties during the week of July 15, 2013.

After careful consideration, Respondent's motion is granted. We strike Appellant's initial brief. Appellant shall file an amended initial brief within thirty days of receipt of the transcript. Appellant shall provide this court with status updates every thirty days.
