**MOTION FOR EXTENSION  
TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF**

The Respondent Donnie Myers respectfully moves this Court for an extension of time until August 12, 2013, by which to file and serve his Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be

Included in the Record on Appeal.

The Respondent Myers's motion is based on the following grounds:

1. The Appellant served his Appellant's Initial Brief by mail on June 12, 2013. The Appellant did not at that same time serve his Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. However, the undersigned counsel called that deficiency to the Appellant's attention, and the Appellant's Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal was received by the Respondent Myers' counsel on June 26, 2013.

2. On July 8, 2013, the Appellant filed a Motion to Allow Late Filings as well as corrected or amended versions of the Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record.

3. The Respondent Myers' counsel forwarded a letter dated July 12, 2013, to the Clerk of the Court of Appeals requesting a thirty day extension to file the Respondent's Initial Brief, unless the Court treated all deadlines as being in abeyance given the Appellant's pending motion.

4. The undersigned counsel then received a letter dated July 19, 2013, from the Clerk of Court advising that the Appellant's motion did not stay the filing deadlines. The Court further gave the Respondent Myers ten days to renew his prior request for an extension. That is the purpose of this motion. The Respondent Myers hereby renews his prior request for a thirty-day extension through August 12, 2013, because of other deadlines, court appearances, as well as vacation time from the office.

WHEREFORE, the Respondent Donnie Myers respectfully requests that he be allowed until August 12, 2013, by which to file and serve his Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal.


