RE: LKQ Pick Your Part Lawsuit

To Whom it Concerns:

I need your help, please.

Charleston County will shortly be in the process of serving you a lawsuit concerning a vehicle disposal that arose at LKQ in North Charleston, South Carolina in 2022.

Thankfully, the North Charleston, South Carolina location from whence the legal issue arose informed me in August of 2023 that they keep their records long past the one-year minimum requirement. They agreed to search out and preserve this particular record.

I've been trying to contact LKQ Corp. directly for several months about this issue. I've just discovered, now that I'm finished with the complex pleadings, that you need to be served as its registered agent.

Will you and your client please accept service immediately by signing for acceptance of service with the Court, and also please agree to an emergency hearing of my Motion for Summary Judgment based on extenuating hardship?

My family has been continually targeted by an ISIS gang and has suffered many losses over the past 2+ years.

I believe some of the gang members and corrupt others who affiliated with them are blocking our reporting to the FBI by making false statements against us since the South Carolina agent left the agency and the case was transferred to San Diego on account of the Subject's primary reported residence. My completing just the necessary reports has been labor-intensive because of the evidence volume.

I need these funds for retaining counsel and/or other emergency expenses on other litigation surrounding the coinciding ISIS terrorism discussed in my lawsuit being served to you by Charleston County.

I also need a good-running vehicle and to help restore my family and ministry (non-profit) following terrorist attacks.

I've tried to hold my trade name two separate times and had to flee the area because of terrorism, forcing me to initiate a third application because the paperwork from the second attempt was left behind.

My third attempt at something that would and should have been simple — if not for terrorist attacks which necessitated my continual personal re-stabilization — is going to cost me more money.

Please review and/or have your client and/or its counsel review the lawsuit that Charleston County serves you as soon as possible. If it's legal or feasible, I can deliver the paperwork electronically.

If you and/or your client and/or counsel would also please consider stipulating to my proposed redactions (to the best of my understanding, motions should be enclosed with service) and please give me the grace of not requesting a dismissal of my claim on basis of my initially-proposed redactions because of terrorism and because of personal information misuse liability to everyone, especially witnesses against our opponents. I am in possession of the non-redacted evidence for you and/or for the Honorable Court if either or both would like them for review confidentially.

Let's please agree to some workable safety plan.

If you are able to accept future service by e-mail or internet publication, please stipulate to one or both as soon as possible. I need to keep my costs low.

Thanks in advance for your consideration.
