
**CONSENT ORDER GRANTING PCR  
 FOR BELATED DIRECT APPEAL  
 PURSUANT TO *WHITE v. STATE***

This matter comes before the Court by way of a post-conviction relief application filed in the above-captioned case.

The PCR application alleges Applicant was denied his right to direct appeal based upon the South Carolina Court of Appeals's dismissal of his appeal for non-compliance with Rule 203(b)(2), SCACR for service of the Notice of Appeal upon the Respondent outside of the ten day time frame. The PCR application requests relief in the form of a belated direct appeal pursuant to *White v. State*, 263 S.C. 110, 208 S.E.2d 35 (1974). Because Applicant did not knowingly, intelligently, or voluntarily waive his right to direct appeal, the parties do hereby agree and consent that he is entitled to a belated direct appeal pursuant to *White v. State*.

Therefore, this Court hereby GRANTS the Applicant's *White v. State* Belated Direct Appeal PCR.




