

On 02/09/2023, while at 2125 Commerce Dr., room 208 (Masters Inn), in the Cayce area of Lexington County, South Carolina, the defendant, Brandon Lamont Richardson, was found to have approximately 115 grams of methamphetamine. This substance was located in a bag of dog food wrapped in latex gloves along with 20 grams of Fentanyl, 4.6 grams of crack cocaine, and twenty-five (25) unknown pills during the execution of a search warrant of his room. A preliminary test was conducted on the crystal like substance with the TruNarc device which resulted in a positive finding. The case is further supported by LCSD case number 23-002778.







I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On 02/09/2023, while at 2125 Commerce Dr., room 208 (Masters Inn), in the Cayce area of Lexington County, South Carolina, the defendant, Brandon Lamont Richardson, was found to have 4.6 grams of crack cocaine. This substance was located in a bag of dog food wrapped in latex gloves along with 20 grams of Fentanyl, 115 grams of methamphetamine, and twenty-five (25) unknown pills during the execution of a search warrant of his room. A preliminary test was conducted on the substance using the TruNarc device which resulted in a positive test. The case is further supported by LCSD case number 23-002778.
