
Dear Ms. Harrison:

In response to your letter dated January 11, 2024, both counsel for Respondent and counsel for Appellant have a date certain jury trial scheduled for the week of May 13-17, 2024, in Greenville County before Judge Morgan that conflicts with the proposed dates for oral argument in this case.
