ORDER

Respondents' counsel notified the Court on September 9, 2022, that the judgment in this case has been satisfied. The Clerk's office sent a letter indicating the appeal would be dismissed; however, the dismissal order was never entered and counsel did not contact the Court to inquire about the status of the case. At this time, our records reflect the case is likely to be orally argued in April of 2024.
