

ORDER

On October 19, 2023, we dismissed this appeal because Appellant failed to provide proof of serving her initial brief and designation of matter on Respondents. On October 27, 2023, Appellant filed a "motion for default judgment." Respondents did not file a return. In the motion, Appellant states she served the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter on Respondents. We construe Appellant's motion for default judgment as a motion to reinstate.
