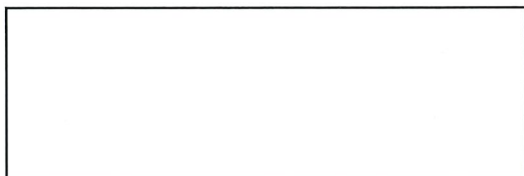
Hi Jordan,
