To the Judge and/or Clerk deciding my case events:

I see that my earlier promises about straightening this action out are taking too long because I allowed myself to get upset about and/or prioritize other matters, which is entirely disrespectful to you, given your previous grace to me.

I reviewed the deficiencies that you noted once I calmed down over the past couple of days. I agree they're ridiculously unacceptable.

I'm making a new motion for extension besides what I've mentioned in my request to waive filing fees. The form I used for such a request is based upon one I finally found to be submitted by a person in Greenville, along with other Supreme Court pleadings that appeared correct to me, but it may also be wrong.

When I reviewed the errors on basic things like the Notice of Appeal, I was appalled. Clearly I was/am overwhelmed.

I'm making a new motion this morning for an extension on my remaining fees and/or other deficiencies, and then I'm updating the Complaint based on work I unfortunately lost that was supposed to be saved online 3-4 moves ago when I couldn't get my laptop on Wifi. I've additionally also argued the entire agreement, it's a good argument, and that work was also lost and has to be re-done.

I'm not even sure a lot of what has to be said can be said or documented by another person because of my firsthand knowledge of what a lot of the events and evidence are, or what they mean, but I think I've almost found an attorney.

In addition, I understand that it's my fault for getting upset about other things and not informing the church about the events on the scale I should have previously to protect their interests on account of being mentioned, and on account of our beliefs about prophecy fulfillment. I haven't wanted to talk to anyone because I am so depressed and exhausted, but am forcing myself to do it so that these circumstances don't keep happening.

I am in a different time zone. I am using the Massachusetts P.O. Box on account of expense and having my mail forwarded, as well as on account of not wanting the Defendant or others who don't like me to know my present location.

Yesterday, my contact lenses became so blurry from crying over the prior days that I couldn't do anymore work. I became so exhausted that I asked my friend here to wake me up after an hour nap in the afternoon.

I believed he said he would, but he misunderstood and didn't do what I asked and assumed he would do.

I woke up at 11:00 p.m. or so our time, realizing you hadn't been e-mailed all that needed to be e-mailed to you by yesterday's deadline. I woke up on my own, despite exhaustion, because of a nightmare I had about a federal appeal. Please don't make me do that. I'll get more help and get everything sorted out.

Please consider my time zone on the hour delay in getting you yesterday's documents. I didn't notarize anything yesterday, but am thinking perhaps I can go to a library and do so today so that you can see we are an hour behind you and/or provide other proof of my actual present location if you, in fact, would even consider that as a reason for the delayed receipt.

There is a single piece of audio evidence that proves the vast majority of the Defendant's allegations against my son and me (breaking in anywhere, smoking where he claimed we did and also blamed others who weren't guilty during "no contact," and other things that even one of Chayban's alliances repeatedly admits we didn't do), but I have to get help and figure out how you accept that kind of evidence.

Please consider a formal motion for one more extension on any deficiencies so that I can at least be sure I've done what needs to be done and served the correct forms or documents on everyone who needed to be served, etc., so that someone else can actually come in and help.

I am sending you that, including evidence of the assault on my son which caused additional confusion and upset on my end (he's okay, but I am overwhelmed) and my income proofs this morning.

Thank you for your mercy. I'm sorry I let you down, but I believe I understand what I did wrong and am seeking to correct it all. The church doesn't deserve to look bad because of my ridiculous mistakes, and you deserve better also. I'm so sorry.
