**MOTION TO SEAL AND/OR REDACT SUPERFLUOUS IDENTIFIERS
FOR PUBLICATION AND SERVICE**

The Defendant is, I believe, highly likely to bother or target other participants (possibly even those who are never mentioned in the action, but he believes might be), especially when the Defendant and/or co-conspirators believe an individual may be a potential witnesses and/or are seeking to gain compliance with Defendant's malicious, faulty narrative against my family and me.

Multiple people knew that we were on the correct side of the law in 2021 when the initial, overt terrorist threats were made and recorded/documented, but Chayban was able to terrorize them (psychological manipulation occurs in all cases) and cause them to fear participation with us and/or incentivize those individuals into overt alignment with him anyway. I feel I can prove that actions representing, in my belief and opinion, recruitment or alignment gained through ISIS terrorism itself, happened to past participants and/or witnesses. I believe they're all technically his victims as U.S. nationals compared to him and his manipulative and terroristic participation.

I pray the Court would seal and/or allow me to redact for publication and service anything identifying or describing the participation of any incidental, loyal U.S. national as defined in 8 USC § 1101(a)(22) who is not absolutely integral to the action *and* who did not specifically agree to be named or identified in any court setting or for publication because I'm afraid for the safety of the litany of participants surrounding the overall case events I must continue to describe.

Even someone I don't particularly like is still a (loyal) U.S. national compared to him, in my opinion, when there has never been a stated allegiance to our enemies.

The Defendant stirs things up too much and makes way too many false allegations against others for a litany of malevolent purposes. ISIS declared the dissemination of disinformation a duty of war. This is the main method he uses to gain control of communities or community segments.
