Petitioner constitutional Right was violated.

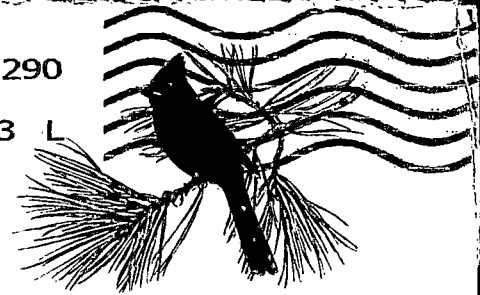
