MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellants Brock Owen McGrew and Anastasia McGrew, through their undersigned counsel, respectfully request a fourteen (14) day extension of time to file Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. This is the Appellants' fourth request for an extension as to these filings. However, it is the second request since the transcript of the underlying case was provided on December 7, 2023. Out of caution, the undersigned requested two earlier extensions despite not having the transcript. Further, counsel has drafted the appeal in the case and it is being reviewed by Appellants.

Most recently, on February 1, 2024, the parties to this litigation have come to a Satisfaction of Judgment that will moot the current appeal. The Satisfaction of Judgment is currently being circulated to the parties for signature and should be complete in the next 14 days. Once this is complete, the undersigned will withdraw the current appeal.

Appellant's Initial Brief is currently due on Monday, February 5, 2024. If this extension is granted, Appellant's new deadline would be Monday, February 19, 2024. Appellants also respectfully request that this Court hold all deadlines in abeyance until an order has been issued on this Motion. Appellants do not request this extension for the impermissible purpose of delay.
