This Court issued an order, dated and filed on December 13, 2022, see attached as Exhibit A, and emailed to Plaintiff on the same date, see email attached as Exhibit B, that ordered and required the following:

1. Sondra Lampl file an Accounting with bank records from the date she was chosen as the Decedent's Agent under Power of Attorney dated January 16, 2014 through the Decedent's death on May 31, 2020. This Accounting is due to this Court by March 1, 2023.
2. Les Shayne is required to communicate with any financial institutions of the Decedent, to include TD Ameritrade, Charles Schwab, Valic, Blue Ridge Bank of Walhalla, Oconee Federal, and PNC, to obtain all bank statements for the Decedent from May 2020 through current. Copies of all bank statements are required to be filed with the Court by January 15, 2023.
3. Les Shayne is required to amend, as necessary, his Inventory and Appraisal by January 15, 2023.

Violative of the law (POA-by Court order - deemed illegal invalid)

Plaintiff is a practicing attorney who is representing himself in his mother's estate litigation as Personal Representative and Plaintiff in this matter. Plaintiff emailed the Court on January 5, 2023, claiming that he did not receive the December 13, 2022 Order until January 4, 2023 and asked the Court to reconsider certain matters regarding the Order, to include additional time to obtain Plaintiff's required records.

Plaintiff responded to the email sending the December 13, 2022 Order by email dated December 23, 2022, see attached as Exhibit C, indicating Plaintiff did receive the Order.

Attorneys are expected and required to attend to their email communications, as it is a mandatory form of communication, see Rule 410 (e) and (g) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Section IV, Rules Governing the Practice of Law.

Additionally, this Court's estate clerk emailed Plaintiff, also on December 13, 2022, with the same requirements that are included in the December 13, 2022 Order, see email attached as Exhibit D, giving no excuse for Plaintiff not receiving or understanding what was required of him as Personal Representative and Plaintiff.

Therefore, Plaintiff's Motion to Reconsider, being outside the ten (10) day time period required by Rule 59(e), SCRPC, is **DENIED**.

Plaintiff and Defendant are **GRANTED** additional time to meet the deadlines required in the December 13, 2022 Order.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Sondra Lampl shall file an Accounting with bank records from the date she was chosen as the Decedent's Agent under Power of Attorney dated January 16, 2014 through the Decedent's death on May 31, 2020. This Accounting is due to this Court by **April 1, 2023 or no later than three (3) months after Defendant is served with this Order, whichever is later.**
2. Les Shayne is required to communicate with any financial institutions of the Decedent, to include TD Ameritrade, Charles Schwab, Valic, Blue Ridge Bank of Walhalla, Oconee Federal, and PNC, to obtain all bank statements for the Decedent from May 2020 through current. Copies of all bank statements are required to be filed with the Court by **February 15, 2023.**
3. Les Shayne is required to amend, as necessary, his Inventory and Appraisement by **February 15, 2023.**
4. **Les Shayne shall have this Order served on Sondra Lampl and file proof of such service with this Court.**

ORDER REQUIRING ACCOUNTING
WITH BANK RECORDS

A Summons and Complaint were filed by the Personal Representative of the Estate of Charlotte Shayne against Sondra Lampl, requesting that she be banned and barred from receiving any share of the Estate of Charlotte Shayne, and that she be required to file a detailed accounting with regard to her spending of Ms. Shayne's money, amongst other relief.

Ms. Sondra Lampl was personally served this Summons and Complaint by the Deputy Sheriff in New Jersey on July 19, 2022, as evidenced by the Affidavit of Service of Personal Service filed with this Court on August 19, 2022. The Defendant Lampl filed no responsive pleadings to the Summons and Complaint within 30 days from service, as evidenced by the Affidavit of Default filed with the Court, dated August 30, 2022 and filed with the Court on September 1, 2022.

A hearing was held on November 22, 2022. All parties were mailed notice of the hearing. Leslie Jay Shayne a/k/a Les Shayne appeared but Defendant Sondra Lampl did not.

On November 23, 2022, the Defendant filed a statement that she was unable to attend the hearing and has not retained counsel and is unable to represent herself.

As the allegations of the Complaint infer that Sondra Lampl, while acting as an agent under a Power of Attorney for Charlotte Sara Weiss Shayne, took or misspent the Decedent's monies, accountings and bank records are required. Plaintiff has not subpoenaed any bank records. Plaintiff as Personal Representative has not obtained any of the Decedent's bank records with his Certificate of Appointment.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Sondra Lampl file an Accounting with bank records from the date she was chosen as the Decedent's Agent under Power of Attorney (dated January 16, 2014 through the Decedent's death on May 31, 2020). This Accounting is due to this Court by March 1, 2023.
2. Les Shayne is required to communicate with any financial institutions of the Decedent, to include TD Ameritrade, Charles Schwab, Valic, Blue Ridge Bank of

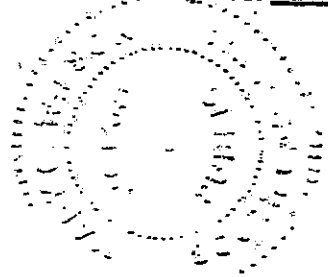
