**MOTION FOR FOURTH EXTENSION OF TIME

I.

The Initial Brief Of Respondent and Designation Of Matter are due to be served and filed today, February 2, 2024.

II.

Pursuant to RE: Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the State moves for a **fourth** extension in the above-referenced criminal appeal and asks for an additional thirty days to complete the brief in this case. In the 30 days since the undersigned last requested an extension, he has filed an initial brief in State v. Shakoya Alexis Darby (2022-001127); a Return To Petition For Rehearing in Carnie Norris v. State (2019-000334); a Brief In Opposition To Petition For Writ Of Certiorari To The Supreme Court Of

South Carolina in State v. Mary Ann German (23-5826); and Returns To Petition For Writ Of Certiorari in State v. Kristy Olympia Davis (2023-002003) and in Derrick Miller v. State (2023-000470).

The undersigned counsel submits this extension request is supported by extraordinary circumstances and is not intended for purposes of delay. The undersigned counsel is currently working on the Brief in this case and intends to have it finished in a timely manner. However, the undersigned counsel has not yet been able to finish the Brief due to a heavy workload. Accordingly, to ensure the Brief is properly researched and prepared, I would therefore request an additional extension of time within which to serve and file the Brief.

WHEREFORE, Respondent prays that the Court extend the deadline for the service and filing of the Initial Brief Of Respondent and Designation Of Matter in this case for thirty days from the date such relief is granted; hold the matter in abeyance pending a ruling on Respondent's motion; and grant such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.


