Dear Ms. Brinson:

The Court received your motion to dismiss. Our records reflect you are a nonlawyer appearing on behalf of the Estate of James Murrell. Pursuant to *Brown v. Coe*, 365 S.C. 664, 620 S.E.2d 323 (2005), a nonlawyer personal representative may not represent an estate on appeal. Therefore, we are returning your motion to you without action.


Additionally, it appears the time to order the transcript in this matter has expired. Within ten days of the date of this letter, the appellant must file a copy of the letter showing that they have timely ordered the transcript from the court reporter. If the appellant has not timely ordered the transcript, they must serve and file a motion requesting permission to order the transcript outside of the filing deadlines set by Rule 207 of the SCACR, along with a copy of the letter addressed to the court reporter.
