

ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order dismissing the complaint. The appellant received written notice of entry of the order on appeal on November 17, 2023, but did not serve the notice of appeal on counsel for the respondents until January 8, 2024. Accordingly, this appeal is dismissed due to the failure to timely serve the notice of appeal. *See* Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR (requiring service of the notice of appeal on all respondents within 30 days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment); *Elam v. S.C. Dep't of Transp.*, 361 S.C. 9, 14-15, 602 S.E.2d 772, 775 (2004) (noting the requirement of timely service of the notice of appeal is jurisdictional). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
