I.

Respondent/Appellant's Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation Of Matter are due to the Court today, February 12, 2024, pursuant to three previous extensions granted by the Court.

II.

Pursuant to RE: Extension Requests in Criminal Direct Appeals and Post-Conviction Relief Certiorari Proceedings: Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009, the Respondent/Appellant moves for a fourth extension in the above referenced appeal. Due to work required in other cases pending before this Court, the South Carolina Supreme Court and the Supreme Court of the United States, I am unable to complete this Brief on time. Since the last extension was granted in this matter I filed a Return to Petition for Rehearing in The State v. Carnie Norris (2023-001439); a Brief in Opposition in South Carolina v. Mary Ann

German (23-5826), a case pending in the Supreme Court of the United States; returns to petitions for writs of certiorari in Eric Harper v. State (2023-000538), Kristy Olympia Davis v. State (2023-002003) and Derrick Miller v. State (2023-000470). In addition to the above matters, I also represented the State in an oral argument before the South Carolina Supreme Court in State v. Adam Martyn Rowell (2022-000571). I would therefore request a **fourth** extension of time within which to serve and file the Respondent/Appellant's Initial Brief Appellant and Designation Of Matter.

This extension request is not intended for purposes of delay, but rather to ensure that the Brief is properly researched and prepared.

WHEREFORE, Respondent/Appellant prays that the Court extend the deadline for the service and filing of the Respondent/Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter of Appellant in this case for thirty (30) days; and for such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.




