Dear Ms. Allen:

Per the Court’s letter of February 7, 2024, we are preparing to have six printed and bound copies of the Record made. We understand that review showed some discrepancies between the printed and bound copies made earlier and the uploaded Record. While we are unclear on that issue, we will certainly forward the copies as instructed. However, the price difference for full color copies and black and white is substantial – and this is a documents case with no photographs or graphic note that this follows our voice mail of yesterday afternoon to Caitlyn, but understand that she likely needed more specifics before she could confirm with the Court and reply regarding the same.

Our review of the three uploaded Volumes of the Record and of the fourth volume, kindly forwarded by Caitlyn, shows the following instances of color appearing in the documents:

- Volume 1: Filing marks from court, judge using blue ink for his emails, blue print in pleading signatures, blue ink to sign pleadings, Affidavits.
- Volume 2: Filing marks from court, blue ink in signatures for pleadings, P 480 – Color ink on Logo on Policy.
- Volume 3: Filing marks from court, blue ink in signatures for pleadings, P 658 – Color ink on Logo on Policy.
- Volume 4: Filing marks from court, blue ink in signatures for pleadings, P 658 – Color Logo. Redacted Stamps in red ink on form, 807-809.
