

ORDER

Respondents filed a motion to strike the final brief of appellant and the record on appeal. Appellant filed a return, opposing the motion to strike her final brief, but acknowledging an error with the index for the record on appeal. Respondents filed a reply. Additionally, Appellant filed a motion to serve and file an amended record on appeal to correct the index. Appellant conditionally filed an amended record on appeal. After careful consideration, we deny Respondents' motion to strike the final brief of appellant and grant Respondents' motion to strike the record on appeal. Also, we grant Appellant's motion to serve and file an amended record on appeal, but we reject the conditionally-filed amended record on appeal because it does not comply with the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("Each page of the Record on Appeal shall be numbered consecutively beginning with the index."). Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that complies with Rule 210, SCACR, within thirty days of the date of this order. Thereafter, Respondents shall file and serve their final brief and Appellant shall serve an amended final brief within twenty days of the date of service of the amended record on appeal.
