**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME FOR APPELLANT
TO SERVE AND FILE INITIAL BRIEF AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER
TO BE INCLUDED IN THE RECORD ON APPEAL**

Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, appellant Taylor Chasey Robertson moves for an extension of time in which to serve and file appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal ("Designation of Matter"). Robertson requests an extension of thirty days to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter which are currently due February 17, 2024. This is the first request for an extension filed by Robertson.
