ORDER

Appellant filed a notice of appeal, challenging a circuit court order dismissing her appeals of four writs of ejectment issued by a magistrate. On November 14, 2023, this court granted Respondent's motion to dismiss the appeal as moot because Appellant voluntarily vacated the property. On November 20, 2023, Appellant filed a return to the motion to dismiss, which this court construed as a petition to reinstate her appeal. Respondent filed a return, and Appellant filed a reply. After careful consideration of the motion to reinstate, the Court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for reinstating the appeal. Accordingly, the motion to reinstate is denied.
