
This is Appellant's first request for an extension and, if granted, the new due date for Appellant's Initial Brief would be August 22, 2013.

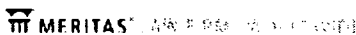
