Basis of Appeal: SC Court of Appeals

To consider the evidence and appeal for indictment 2023-GS-03857 Resisting Arrest (NMT 10 years +/- \$1,000-\$10,000) (16-09-0320 (B)) (2023-GS-46-03857).

The evidence that will be presented or a basis for an appeal is given will contain the trial date, which was issued by the municipal court for Nov 1, 2023; the initial plea charge of resisting arrest w/o assault (30 days NMT 1 year +/- \$1,000), failure to identify (30 days \$1,087.50); damage to personal property (30 days \$2125). The evidence will also show a video of the hotel and body camera from arresting officer Emma Orr Costa.

Basis for an Appeal:

It is clearly stated that the charges should/or could have been dismissed and issued time served for the accountability of being imprisoned for over the time allotted with each initial charge. Respecting the immediate response from judge Daniel Hall on January 31, 2024 with also the plea of guilty; the charges were already sentenced and served by the CTS (credit for time served) and needs

for dismissal should and/or could be administered  
by default of the plea.

### Conclusion:

As for evidence and clear statements which can be proven in a courtroom; the case or indictment number 2023-GS-46-03857 should and/or could be ruled for a dismissal or dropped in (defendant's) Kinyadza Moses's favor. Also, this case has put a delay in other parts of the time spent in the York County Detention Center and the appellant's life that has caused tremendous monetary and emotional dilemmas which may or may not result in litigations; which could also prove the defendant's "not guilty plea" when first receiving a public attorney.

The appellant's case is clearly and notably a easy case to consider for approval and the defendant also has a respectable reputation in the business and professional community within their lives that has been consumed fairly devastated by this case.
