number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Johnson Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of David James Lamont Brice v. State with the Supreme Court on January 25, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Court of Appeals in the case of The State v. Michael T. Means with the Supreme Court on January 12, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


