I Detavious Cunningham is currently serving a 16 year 85% sentence in South Carolina Department of Correctional. My charge is second offense trafficking, more than 28g but less than 100, which puts me in violation of §44-53-375(c) of S.C. Code of Laws, bearing CDR code # 0389 stated on my sentencing sheet. This is technically a default on my sentencing sheet due to the same statute on my indictment paperwork, which is Trafficking In Crack Cocaine SC Code §44-53-375(c) and CDR:0349. With that being said my sentencing sheet does not state the same CDR Code as my indictment paperwork. Due to forgery of CDR Code: 0389, I would like to have my case dismissed

Or have my sentence vacated.
Defendant, who was sentence for
drug offense as a first offender, wrong
classified and treated as a second
offender, and subsequently charge
with violating conditions of Community
Supervision Program (CSP), had served
more than original sentence of
four years imprisonment, and thus,
was entitled to be released from CSP,
warrant, indictment, and sentencing
sheet all listed statute indicating
first offense, Defendant's placement
and participation in CSP was result
of being treated second offender, as
indicated by Criminal Docket Report
(CDR) code on sentencing sheet, and
additional listing of CDR code, indicating
second offense, could not trump statute
State v. Bennett (S.C. App. 2007) 375 S.C.
165, 650 S.E. 2d 490. On another note
how can I be indicted 3 days before

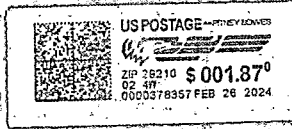

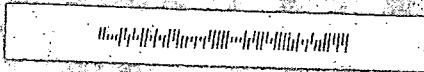
