

COMES NOW the Defendant, by and through undersigned counsel, and files this Second Motion for a speedy trial in the above matter pursuant to the 6th Amendment to the US constitution and Article 1, Section 14 of the SC Constitution.

By way of procedural history, the Defendant filed a motion for a speedy trial on December 1, 2022. The motion came before the court in front of the Honorable Edward Miller on the date of May 19, 2023. Before the hearing the Solicitor informed the court that the case would probably be heard November of 2023 although it could happen after that date and might occur next year. As a result, the court did not seem to definitely rule on the motion for a speedy trial. This motion is to clarify that the Defendant does not waive his request for a speedy trial and that he requests a definite date set for the trial and that the case be set immediately.

The Defendant therefore moves a second time for a speedy trial. He also would request that the court set a definite time for the trial. The Defendant is concerned that this case will take an undue time to come to trial.

In the alternative, this Defendant moves for immediate dismissal of the above indictments for failure of the state to prosecute this case in a timely manner.
