1. The Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.


2. Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Johnny Haggins v. The State with the Court of Appeals on February 28, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Justen L. Wilkes v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 12, 2024. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Devatee Tymar Clinton v. The State on February 6, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Demetrius A. Goodwin v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 16, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Jeremiah Johnson v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 8, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Celia Windham with the Court of Appeals on January 5, 2024. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Mitchell Rivers v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 2, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Lillian Mae Bates with the Court of Appeals on December 11, 2023. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Anthony M. Wise v. The State with the Supreme Court on December 6, 2023.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


