Applicant, William G. Richbourg #250006, provides the following explanations, why the lower courts ruling that applicants PCR was successive or untimely, was improper:

- 1) applicant never received a Requested Direct appeal;

- 6) the only issue the Clerk had with applicant was that he did not file the original opposition, but only a copy. Applicant wrote an explanation to the Clerk.
