

ORDER

After careful consideration, Respondent's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is granted pursuant to *Ex parte Martin*, 321 S.C. 533, 471 S.E.2d 134 (1995). Respondent's motion to file his briefs and other documents without covers or bindings is granted to the extent that Respondent may provide only one unbound original and no copies for any document filed. The document must still include a cover and all documents must be served on Appellant. In the event this court determines additional copies of certain filings are required, additional copies may be requested.

Attorney Overture E. Walker's motion to be relieved as counsel for Respondent is granted. Counsel's motion to appoint counsel for Respondent is denied. *See Evitts v. Lucey*, 469 U.S. 387, 394 (1985) (holding the "right to counsel is limited to the first appeal as of right"). However, this appeal will be held in abeyance for thirty days to allow Respondent to procure alternative counsel. If a notice of appearance is not filed by new counsel within thirty days, this court will presume Respondent is proceeding pro se.
