

## ORDER

Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is denied. *See Martin v. State*, 321 S.C. 533, 535, 471 S.E.2d 134, 134-35 (1995) ("In the absence of a statutory provision allowing the general waiver of filing fees, we conclude motions to proceed in forma pauperis may only be granted where specifically authorized by statute or required by constitutional provisions."). The filing fee must be paid within fifteen days of the date of this order and this appeal will be dismissed.

Appellant's motions to seal the lower court case records, her motion to redact, and her motion to serve Respondent via publication on the internet are also denied.
