Upon and or during the time he was detained at that detention Center a initial magistrate court appereance was never held. Mr. Bedford never signed a extradition wavier and a extradition hearing was never held or conducted.

② on 12-01-21 Mr. Bedford was transported from the previous stated (G.A) detention center to the Pageland, SC Jail. Mr. Bedford requested a Attorney but was never provided A Attorney and a magistrate court Judge denied bond on Charges "2021A1320700217 & 2021A1320700218"

③ on 01-11-22 Mr. Bedford attorney filed a Motion to Set Bond for Charges 2021A1320700217 & 2021A1320700218. That hearing was held and conducted on 02-10-22 and Bond was denied. On 03-03-22 Mr. Bedford presiding attorney requested to be release as counsel due to health issues.

(4) on 04-04-22 Mr. Bedford was indicted on Charges "CHE00442 & CHE00443" A hearing was held and conducted on 04-04-22 in reference to set Bond for all above listed charges However bond was denied. On 05-13-22 Mr. Bedford Presiding attorney for uncertain reasons withdrew as Counsel.

(5) on 07-26-22 Mr. Bedford attorney that withdrew on 05-13-22 Motion to be Relieve as Counsel was held and conducted on 07-26-22 At and or During that hearing bond was requested But Denied.

(6) on 12-01-22 Mr. Bedford attorney filed a Motion For Bond That hearing was held and Conducted on 04-27-23 and Bond Was Denied. On 11-21-23 that attorney filed motion to be Relieve as Counsel in Witch that hearing was held and conducted on 02-22-24 in witch that attorney motion was Granted. Subsequently as of 02-23-24 Mr. Bedford is currently without A Attorney. Mr. Bedford has been detained since 10-10-21.

Mr. Bedford has been denied bond six(6) times but ~~before~~ believe he meets pretrial release etiquette.

ORDER SPECIFYING METHODS AND CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

Offense Charged: OBSTRUCTING / Grand Larceny More than \$2000 less than 10,000

At a bail proceeding conducted by the undersigned judge, for the defendant named above, it was determined by the court (check one or both):

- The release of the defendant on recognizance will not reasonably assure his appearance as required.
- The release of the defendant on recognizance will result in an unreasonable danger to the community.

This determination was based upon the following findings of fact: DUE TO PENDING MISSING PERSON INVESTIGATION AND THE DEFENDANT BEING THE LAST ONE TO BE SEEN WITH MISSING PERSON BOND IS DENIED

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That the above named defendant be released from custody on the condition that he will personally appear before the designated court at the place, date and time required to answer the charge made against him and do what shall be ordered by the court and not depart the State without the permission of the court and be of good behavior.
2. That the above named defendant be released from custody provided as follows (check all that apply):
