This court filed an opinion in the case on 1-17-2024 which Appellant received on 1-19-2024. On 1-26-2024, Appellant filed a motion for an extension of time to file a petition for rehearing and asked that the court extend the time 30 days from the date of the order granting the extension so that appellant is aware of the deadline to complete the petition for rehearing. On 2-8-2024. This court issued a deficiency notice to appellant to correct and provide proof of service. On 4-12-2024 Appellant corrected those errors. 3-1-2024, this court issued an order granting appellants motion for an extension of time which appellant received by mail on 3-4-2024. The order provides that appellant has until 3-4-2024 to file a petition for rehearing which is not enough notice to complete the petition so that it is filed before the due date. Appellant requested that the extension be 30 days from the date of the order because Appellant has multiple cases that he is constantly having to respond to and document deadlines and that he needs to be aware of the deadline in enough to file the petition on time. By the current order of this court and the timeframe in which appellant received notice of the 3-1-2024 order in this case, appellant has had less than 24 hours to be aware that the deadline to file the rehearing is 3-4-2024 which is not enough time or notice. Appellant, Nelson L. Bruce, hereby respectfully moves pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, for a 2<sup>nd</sup> 30-day extension of time from 3-4-2024 to serve and file Appellant's Petition for Rehearing of Matters in this case extending the deadline to 4-3-2024. For these reasons, Appellant believes there is good cause to grant a 2<sup>nd</sup> request for a 30-day extension.

WHEREFORE Appellant prays for an Order extending the time in which to file appellant's Petition for rehearing for thirty (30) days from the current deadline which is 3-4-2024 making the new deadline 4-3-2024. This motion is not being presented to cause unnecessary

delay, or for any other improper purpose. This requested extension of time is much needed so appellant has enough time to sufficiently review the record, completely draft a petition for rehearing related to the opinion of the court, and get it filed by the due date with sufficient notice.
