ORDER

On March 11, 2013, this appeal was held in abeyance pending the supreme court's rehearing of *Bone v. U.S. Food Service*, 399 S.C. 566, 733 S.E.2d 200 (2012). The supreme court has now issued its decision. *See Bone v. U.S. Food Serv.*, ___ S.C. ___, 744 S.E.2d 552 (2013). Based upon that decision, we no longer hold this appeal in abeyance.
