MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI
AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Robert C. Cribb, respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days from March 21, 2024, until April 22, 2024, in which to serve and file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Robert C. Cribb respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances

exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the Brief of Petitioner in the case of Johnny Haggins v. The State with the Court of Appeals on February 23, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Justen L. Wilkes v. The State with the Supreme Court on February 12, 2024. Counsel appeared before the Court of Appeals for Oral Argument in the case of Devatee Tymar Clinton v. The State on February 6, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Demetrius A. Goodwin v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 16, 2024. Counsel filed the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in the case of Jeremiah Johnson v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 8, 2024. Counsel filed the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in the case of The State v. Celia Windham with the Court of Appeals on January 5, 2024. Counsel filed the Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the case of Mitchell Rivers v. The State with the Supreme Court on January 2, 2024.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


