

Our office is in receipt of the 990 page transcript in the above matter that was transcribed by you. Unfortunately, I am required to challenge the accuracy of the transcript. For 474 times the word "inaudible" appears in the transcript. Many times the word appears in either the question from an attorney or the answer of a witness. In addition, six times "wRourke" appears in the transcript on pages 206, 224, 282, 309 (2) and 345. In context, the word is presumed to be "worked." This would need to be corrected.

In addition, on page 571 the testimony of the complaining witness is being given. On page 572, the testimony is of Mr. Oswald. On page 586 at page at line 15, the testimony of the complaining witness abruptly starts again which interrupted the testimony of Mr. Oswald. As I have not completed the reading of the transcript, I do not know of other possible errors.

Please advise as to when the corrected transcript will be provided.
